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Check out the frog's tongue. Then move your own tongue in your mouth. Where is your tongue attached? Where is the frog's tongue attached? Why do you think they are opposite?

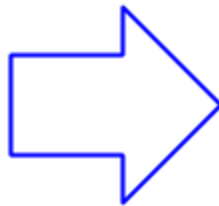
What is one structure that the frog has that helps it survive?
