

Live Screen Sharing from an AIO 2D Mode

Live content provides the opportunity for “**just in time**” interaction between the presenter and viewers. The presenter can pause to ask or answer questions and respond to feedback. Presenting live from zSpace requires use of an AIO. When presenting live content without a secondary screen, it is necessary to use zSpace in **2D Display Mode** in order to avoid video issues when using video conferencing software.

Disable 3D Display Mode via Windows OS settings:

To turn off 3D Display Mode:

1. Right click with the mouse on the desktop
2. Locate Display Settings for Windows
3. Slide to off

When you are ready to begin remotely share live content:

1. Start your video conference.
2. Share your screen.
3. Use the stylus within the application.

Important:

Remember to turn 3D Display Mode back on when not presenting live.
