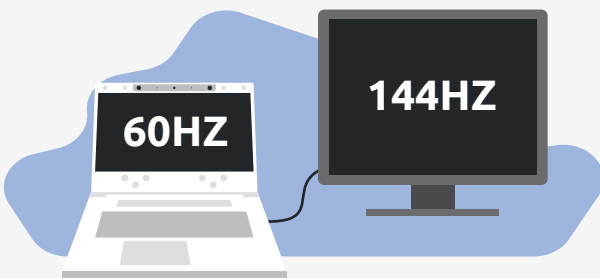


Esports Inspire Set up Recommendations

Highly Recommended

Using external gaming monitor (144hz refresh)





Using a 144hz (versus 60hz for internal display) gaming display is recommended since anything faster than this leads to diminishing returns on a laptop. If the display will also be used for desktop gaming systems, going beyond 144hz for a display is fine, but do not expect to get more than 144hz on the Inspire for gaming.

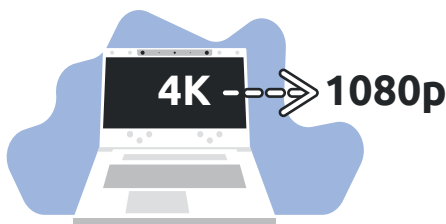
Benefits of using an external display:

- Ability to leave internal display at 4K for Stereo 3D zSpace applications and 1080p on gaming display all the time
- Larger screen
- Faster response time (2-6ms for external gaming display, 21ms for internal IPS 4K display)

Maximize Gaming Monitor refresh rate:

1. Right click on Desktop
2. Select Display Settings
3. Select Secondary Monitor (**Click identify to verify**)
4. Select Advanced Display Settings
5. Select Maximum Refresh Rate from drop down menu - May require image to be pushed to the secondary display to hold refresh rate ( Windows +  P - Second Screen Only)

Using Internal Display



Reduce Internal Display Resolution on the Inspire from 4K (3840 x 2160) to 1080p (1920x1080)

1. Right click on Desktop
2. Select Display Settings
3. Verify Display 1 in selected (Click identify to verify)
4. Change Resolution to 1920x1080
5. Click Apply

Make sure to return to the default recommended 4K resolution to use 3D zSpace applications again. 3D only works when the internal display is at 4k resolution!

Network Connection



Wired connection offers optimal connection speeds

- For **wireless** connection, download games to maximize performance
- Multiplayer mode does require connection

Gaming Mouse/Gamepad



Wired gaming mouse or gamepad is recommended for optimal performance

Wired gaming keyboard can also be used
